The Abstract must be prepared according to the guidelines listed below. The file must be saved as a Word Rich Text Format. Whole text in Times/Times New Roman font, single linespacing. Borders at 2.5 cm from top, bottom and right edges, 4.0 cm from left edge. Title centered, size 14, upper case, bold; authors centered, size 12, bold; addresses centered, size 12, plain text; abstract body justified, size 12, plain text, indent 1.0 cm.

This template is already prepared in the required format, so you can copy and paste you text in it.

The Abstract must be coincide and self explanatory. There is no fixed length, as far as the text, along with eventual figures, can be fitted in a single printed page. The figures must be included in the text as jpeg or gif files.
